## **ELECTION JUDGE**

Election judges will receive training and an instruction manual.

Judges are paid via mail after the day of the election.

An election judge receives \$105 for working each election.

A supervisor judge receives \$125 for working each election.

Election judges receive \$25 for training.

Election judges receive mileage reimbursement for being responsible for returning election materials to the County Clerk on election night.

Each year there could possibly be 6 elections to be held on February, March, April, June, August or November.

### ***Qualifications:***

1. You must be a registered voter.
2. You must declare your political party preference.
3. You must be able to speak, read and write in English.
4. You must be of good repute and character.
5. You must be able to lift moderate sized objects.

The election judge's hours are from 5:00 a.m. until after the polling places have closed, until after the last voter has voted and until after the poll has been closed down by the election judges. All election judges are to remain to assist at the poll until it is time for the Supervisory Judges to bring in the election returns to the Administration Office. The polling places are open for voting from 6:00 a.m. until 7:00 p.m.

***Election Judges duties include, but are not limited to the following:***

- \*Arriving at 5:00 a.m. on election day
- \*Maintain general supervision of poll
- \*Setting up the polling place
- \*Arranging tables and chairs for judges and voters
- \*Setting up privacy voting booths
- \*Setting up the voting equipment
- \*Ensuring voters are at the proper polling location
- \*Checking voters for proper identification
- \*Looking up voters' names in the precinct roster
- \*Calling the County Clerk's office to determine the eligibility of a voter
- \*Having voters sign the precinct roster
- \*Issuing the proper ballot to voters
- \*Instructing voters how to vote their ballot
- \*Instructing voters on where to put their voted ballot
- \*Periodically checking to ensure the number of signatures in the roster matches the number of ballots in the ballot box
- \*Giving proper election information to voters
- \*Closing the polling location promptly at 7:00 p.m.
- \*Gathering supplies/ballots and returning them to County Clerk's office

***Training:***

The Jefferson County Clerk's office is committed to providing our judges with the most comprehensive and up to date information. Therefore, we offer classes for each election. One three (3) hour training class is held around the county at convenient locations. Judges are paid \$25 for attending a class. All new judges are required to attend a session and all returning judges are encouraged to attend as election laws may change from year to year.
